Don't forget, enter our fishing contest. Winner will receive \$15.00 in tackle merchandise. We register date of catch, type of catch, and weight. This contest began April 1st. and will close October 1, 1976.

On the reverse side is a map of all local area fishing lakes, streams, and rivers. Twelve (12) popular fishing holes are circled for your convenience:

- 1. Burke Lake Known for good crappie fishing in the Spring; bluegill, large mouth bass and catfish during Summer, and Big muskie in Winter.
- 2. Fountainhead Park is a fairly new marina on the Occoquan Reservoir. This area is known for excellent crappie fishing in warm months. Beautiful water for toating, canoeing, and stocked with very large tass.
- 3. Bull Run Marina Located on the Occoquan Reservoir and is also the same water. Fishermen have experienced much success here in the past.
- 4. Manassas Dam Opened this Spring to public fishing with a new marina, as well. Fishing is also permitted below the Dam.
- 5. <u>Lake Brittle</u> This is an old established Lake with <u>very</u> good fishing of all kinds lots of crappie!
- 6. Shenandoah River Known for its many small-mouth tass which are sometimes plentiful in the rapids - caught on live minnows and worms.
- 7. Fairfax Water Supply (Also known as Goose Creek and Beaver Dam Creek). Just opened Spring of 1975. Fishing was excellent the first year. Let's hope it will hold that record again this year. Bass, bluegill, catfish, and carp.
- 8. Lake Fairfax This location allows swimming and boating in the lake, however, many large bass have been caught in the past here.
- 9. <u>Lake Ann</u> Reston, Va., is a beautiful lake with small sail boats allowed, but was stocked with many fish recently. Record bass have been pulled out of this lake just recently. (See picture on our bulletin board)
- 10. Timber Lake This is also a recreational area with swimming and boating, but is known for morning fishermen's delight in nice catches.
- 11. Great Falls Located at the Potomac River with lots of white water and rapids and known for 40 and 50 pound catfish, big bass, small mouth bass, and lots of everything including herring.
- 12. Chain Bridge The snagging and dipping of herring and shad, capital! Also included are many, many prime white perch.
