### **ORCHESTRA SYLLABUS 2014-2015**

Course Description – The goal of every TJ Orchestra is to perform challenging orchestral literature, build technique, and gain general musical knowledge through studying music of varied styles and eras. In addition to in-class performances and concerts, the groups afford students the opportunity to perform in district, state, and national level ensembles.

**Course Expectations** 

- Be technically prepared for class
- Bring all equipment/pencil
- Be on time for class
- Attend/participate in performances
- Practice your music outside of class
- Wear required concert attire to performances
- Adhere to all existing TJHSST policies regarding dress, behavior, and attendance
- Participate responsibly in rehearsals
  - o Play your music demonstrating details discussed
  - o Listen to instruction
  - o Give your best effort every time
  - Provide leadership/assistance to others
  - Model all aspects of musical excellence and professional protocol in rehearsals and performances.

Grading Policy

### 40% - Weekly Grade.

Students will receive one grade each week based on their ability to adhere to the expectations set out above. Playing tests may also be included in this grade. If a student does not earn an A that week I will notify them and explain what areas they need to improve upon so that the grade can be brought up in the weeks to follow.

#### 60% - Concerts

This is a performing ensemble. Attendance at all concerts is crucial to the success of the group and is mandatory. Students must contact the director as soon as they are aware of the conflict. Excusing an absence is up to the director's discretion. If the absence is excused, the student must play the concert material for the director and will receive a grade based on that performance. Unexcused absences are not able to complete the make-up assignment.
