

1970s Skateparks

from in and around Alexandria, VA



Located on Wheeler Ave. in Alexandria, Skateworld opened in the fall of 1977. This park had an in ground pool with coping, bowls, ramps and a great half pipe.

This Skatepark was on Spring Mall Road on the south side of the then Springfield Mall. The Mall Wall had 2 Snake Runs a baby bowl and a street run in the middle. The Mall Wall closed in 1978 and was bought by Skateworld, then later re-opened as Skateworld West.



This Skatepark opened in 1978 on Hickory Ave. in Waldorf, MD. They had the "White Lighting" giant rolling half-pipe, the "K-2" double pool, the Devil's Drop single pool, a freeform area and a 200 ft slalom run.

In 2002, a citizens group worked with the city government to build a public skatepark.



The 12,000-sq ft park opened in 2003 with a variety of ramps, rails jumps, pipes & wedges.
