Heritage Music Festival to San Antonio Texas!

GENERAL INFORMATION AND PAYMENT DETAILS

WHEN? We leave on Wednesday, March 25, and return Sunday, March 29, 2015.

WHO? All of the Langley Choirs are included in this trip. The spring trip is not a requirement, but it is a unique opportunity for all choral department students to spread their wings, support each other in competition, and just have fun.

WHAT'S THE MAIN EVENT? We'll be competing with choirs from around the country in a national music festival adjudicated by a top-ranked panel of judges. What a great chance to show off our amazing talents!

JUST A COMPETITION? No way! We'll enjoy San Antonio with its many attractions, ending with an awards ceremony and a cookout at Six Flags[®] Flesta Texas!

WILL MOM AND DAD APPROVE? Yes! Chorus trips are very well chaperoned with one adult for every 8 students. We're proud to say that Langley Choirs routinely receive accolades both for their exceptional singing and their exceptional "sportsmanship" at these spring trip music festivals. And Dr. Lambert will be along to keep us all in tune and on our best behavior.

OK, HOW MUCH? The estimated cost for each student is \$1,000, — based on a quad room, but the final cost will be based on the total number of students and chaperones, as well as fundraising results. The cost for each chaperone is estimated to be \$125 higher based on a double room. A \$200 non-refundable deposit must be paid by check and must accompany the Letter of Intent. After this initial deposit, three payments will be due, one each in November, December, and January. Any student wishing to participate in the Spring Trip who is unable to do so because of financial issues should talk privately with Dr. Lambert. The discussion will be treated confidentially. The student will be asked to raise part of the fees through fundraising opportunities and the balance provided by a scholarship fund.

WHAT'S INCLUDED? Bus transportation to-and-from all airports, (except pick-up from the return flight from the arrival airport) around San Antonio, round-trip airfare, baggage fee (for 1 bag of 40 pounds or under), hotel accommodations for 4 nights and entrance fees to all of the attractions, breakfast each day and a minimum of two dinners. Each student will need to bring spending money for the remaining meals and personal purchases.

SO HOW DO I SIGN UP?

Fill out the Letter of Intent and attach a non-refundable deposit of \$ 200 for each student/chaperone. Return NO LATER THAN September 19, 2014.
