2015-2016 West Potomac Band and Ensemble Fees

FCPS and the West Potomac Band will not charge students a fee for any mandatory aspect of the West Potomac Band program except for musical instrument and course material fees that are permitted by the Virginia Department of Education regulations. Schools cannot require a student to pay fees for course materials in excess of the amount approved by the FCPS School Board in Notice 5922.

The following is a description of the West Potomac High School Band course material fees and FCPS-sponsored optional activity fees for participation in the music program for the upcoming season.

Band Course Materials Fee Due June 15, 2015	\$20	EVERYONE	Consumable Items/expenses for the bands/ensembles throughout the school year. Some examples of these items include uniform, uniform accessories/maintenance, instrument accessories, music, food for instructional trips, etc. Any remaining collected fees will be allocated to a uniform replacement fund.
Marching Band Fee Due June 15, 2015	\$180	Marching Band members only	Consumable items/expenses for the marching band season. Examples of these items include band t-shirt, drill book, uniform, uniform accessories/maintenance, shoes, instrument accessories, music/copyright, food during instructional activities/trips, etc. Any remaining collected fees will be allocated to a uniform replacement fund.

FCP5 Sponsored Optional Activity Fee

This is a fee that students are expected to pay if they choose to participate in any activities/trips associated with the West Potomac Band. This fee is determined and assessed based on the estimated cost of the trip/activity – including such costs as costumes and accessories, equipment, transportation, accommodations, registration, food; and other miscellaneous expenses: Examples of trips/activities would include Marching Guard and Dance, Indoor Guard, Indoor Percussion, and Band Trip(s). Students who do not pay the fees associated with a trip/activity will be ineligible to perform/participate in the trip/activity.

Musical Instrument Rental Fee:

This required fee only applies to students who play school-owned instruments and covers maintenance costs of those school-owned instruments. No fee will be charged for an instrument when a student:

- Has been asked by the director to play a different instrument in order to meet a specific need of the band.
- Is unable to transport their instrument to school for music class.
- Must participate in the instrumental music program.

Students who are eligible to be on free/reduced meal plans pay \$20.

Dear Wolverine Band families,

It takes money to run a great high school band program, which is why every FCPS band has a booster club.

Ours is called the West Potomac Band Patrons Organization (WPBPO), and this year, as in the past few years, we're slated to add about \$60,000 + to the band program's bottom line. More than half of that money is from fundraisers, and the rest is from the annual voluntary contributions we receive from each participant.

It would be impossible to run the West Po band program without the booster funding,

We try to ask for as small a check as possible from our families. We accomplish that in two ways: 1) by fundraising as much as we can as a group, and 2) by running "lean and mean." Our program is arguably the best in the county — we achieved both the coveted Honor Band and Blue Ribbon status this year — and yet our participants end up paying less than most other high schools. We are tremendously proud of that.

The money raised by this booster club is used to enrich the Wolverine program in many ways. Among other things, it goes toward hiring extra, expert staff to work with the students on both music and marching skills. We buy uniforms and instruments, carts and equipment. We cover fees for competitions, and help provide buses to get the kids there. We also add a bit of fun in the form of things like student awards and recognition for seniors.

So what's the bottom line for you?

If your child is in marching band, guard or dance team, we'll be requesting a voluntary contribution of \$185 on the first day of pre-season rehearsal (8/17/15).

If your child is only participating in concert band, we'll be requesting a voluntary contribution of \$25 on the first day of classes (9/8/15).

We're looking forward to another fantastic year of music. Thank you for everything you do to support your child's musicianship and this program.
